

DRIVE FISHERS

106TH STREET AND ELLER ROAD

Drive Fishers is the City of Fishers' initiative to increase travel efficiency, improve connectivity and maintain the sanitary sewer and water infrastructure via innovative projects and a proactive approach to construction and maintenance.

Since 2012, Drive Fishers has completed traffic calming projects, sanitary and storm sewer projects, 29 resurfaced lane miles, 6.5 trails and sidewalks, and received more than \$20 million in grants, improving the infrastructure in Fishers while leveraging federal dollars to save money for the Fishers' taxpayers.

Infrastructure improvement projects contribute to long-term vitality of our community and increased economic development opportunities.

PROJECT SCOPE

The City of Fishers is constructing a westbound right-turn lane on 106th Street to northbound Eller Road. Improvements to this four way stop are being implemented in an effort to ease traffic flow during peak hours.

While construction totals at \$183,000, the City of Fishers has secured funding from INDOT to help cover the expense of the intersection. The City of Fishers will fund the remaining \$43,000 to complete this project.

Construction on the intersection is scheduled to begin in September, and is slated for completion by October 2015.

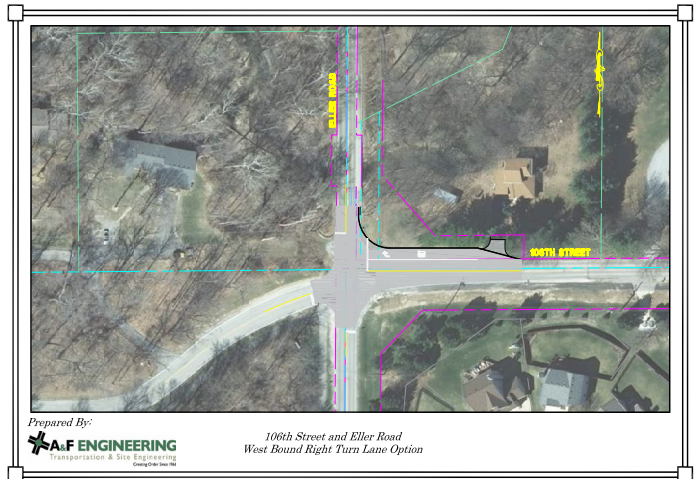
