

DRIVE FISHERS

96TH STREET AND LANTERN ROAD ROUNDABOUT

Drive Fishers is the City of Fishers' initiative to increase travel efficiency, improve connectivity and maintain the sanitary sewer and water infrastructure via innovative projects and a proactive approach to construction and maintenance.

Since 2012, Drive Fishers has completed traffic calming projects, sanitary and storm sewer projects, 33 resurfaced lane miles, 8 miles of trails and sidewalks, and received more than \$60 million in grants, improving the infrastructure in Fishers while leveraging federal dollars to save money for the Fishers' taxpayers.

Infrastructure improvement projects contribute to long-term vitality of our community and increased economic development opportunities.

PROJECT SCOPE

A roundabout is being constructed on 96th Street at the intersection of Lantern Road. While utility work will begin in 2016, construction on the roundabout will begin in spring 2017. This project will transform the existing signalized intersection into a multi-lane roundabout that will improve connectivity and traffic flow in the area. This project also includes the addition of sidewalks and lighting near the roundabout to improve pedestrian access and safety in the area.

The City of Fishers is contributing \$510,000 to this project. The status of this project will be updated as information is available. Motorists are also encouraged to sign up for Drive Fishers weekly construction updates for ongoing communication about the project as construction begins.

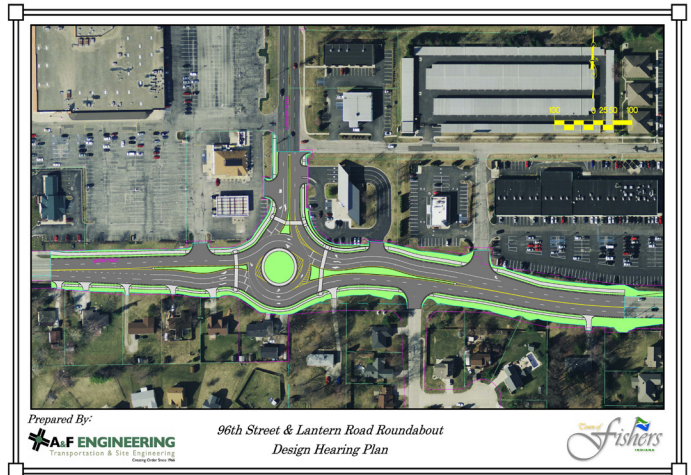
