



## CYNTHEANNE ROAD REHABILITATION

Drive Fishers is the City of Fishers' initiative to increase travel efficiency, improve connectivity and maintain the sanitary sewer and water infrastructure via innovative projects and a proactive approach to construction and maintenance.

Since 2012, Drive Fishers has completed traffic calming projects, sanitary and storm sewer projects, 33 resurfaced lane miles, 8 miles of trails and sidewalks, and received more than \$60 million in grants, improving the infrastructure in Fishers while leveraging federal dollars to save money for the Fishers' taxpayers.

Infrastructure improvement projects contribute to long-term vitality of our community and increased economic development opportunities.

### PROJECT SCOPE

Cyntheanne Road is being rehabilitated from Southeastern Parkway to 136th Street. Rehabilitation will include the widening of the existing 10' travel lanes to 12' travel lanes in an effort to improve traffic flow and improve motorists safety. The entire road will be resurfaced after the widening is complete.

Additional details about this project will be included in the Drive Fishers weekly construction update. Residents are encouraged to sign up for weekly updated to plan a safe commute while road projects are taking place in the community.
