- Present were Selina Stoller, Crystal Neumann, John Weingardt, City Clerk Jennifer Kehl, Chris Greisl, Jocelyn Vare, and Larry Lannan.

Chris Greisl handed out binders to the members of the task force.

- The Municipal Code was established. The items related to the City Council based on State Statute. The code is informal and for general information. The Council Procedures were established two years later.
 - The City Council can establish committees as they need.
 - There are two types of committees Standing Committees and Special Committees. Special Committees dissolve over time.
 - The Standing Committees need to be identified.
 - Rolls Need to be determined – How information will flow between committees to council.
 - Give direction – Formalize how to report back to the council.
 - Chris asked the members to review the binder and other cities procedures and give him feedback so he can draft the ordinance.
 - Selina wants a minimal amount of structure so there is flexibility.
 - Crystal agrees with Selina.
 - The council and the public need to know how its structured but the council needs flexibility.
 - Jocelyn asked if these procedures would determine how membership occurs. Chris said it could.
 - Cecilia said there should be information included on when a member should recuse themselves from voting.
 - Jocelyn asked to have the city staff member or director of the department identified that is connected to the committee.
