

INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT AT 136TH STREET & CYNTHEANNE ROAD

Drive Fishers is the City of Fishers' initiative to increase travel efficiency, improve connectivity and maintain the sanitary sewer and water infrastructure via innovative projects and a proactive approach to construction and maintenance.

Since 2012, Fishers has completed traffic calming projects, sanitary and storm sewer projects, 53 resurfaced lane miles of streets, installed 11 miles of trails and sidewalks, and received more than \$60 million in grants, improving the infrastructure in Fishers while leveraging federal dollars to save money for the Fishers' taxpayers.

Infrastructure improvement projects contribute to the long-term vitality of our community and increased economic development opportunities.

PROJECT SCOPE

An intersection improvement project is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2018 at the intersection of 136th Street and Cyntheanne Road. This project will turn the current four way stop intersection into a one lane roundabout intersection. The roundabout will be built large enough to accommodate lane markings for a two lane roundabout in the future should that become necessary. Work will include: pavement removal and replacement, the installation of crosswalks for pedestrian traffic in all directions, and new lighting. Improvements will increase traffic capacity and improve the safety of the intersection for motorists and pedestrians.

The intersection will be closed for approximately 45 days beginning in July for the construction of the roundabout. This closure is dependent on weather and utility relocation. During construction, updates about the project will be posted on weekly construction updates or via the Drive Fishers Twitter page. 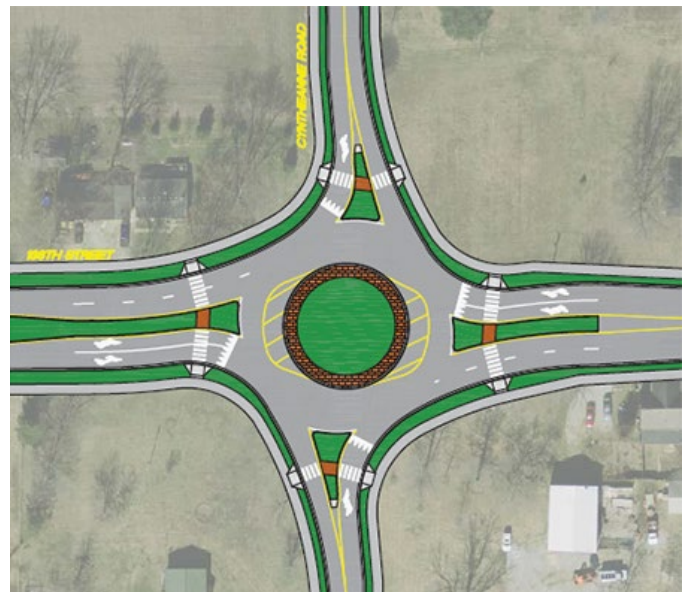

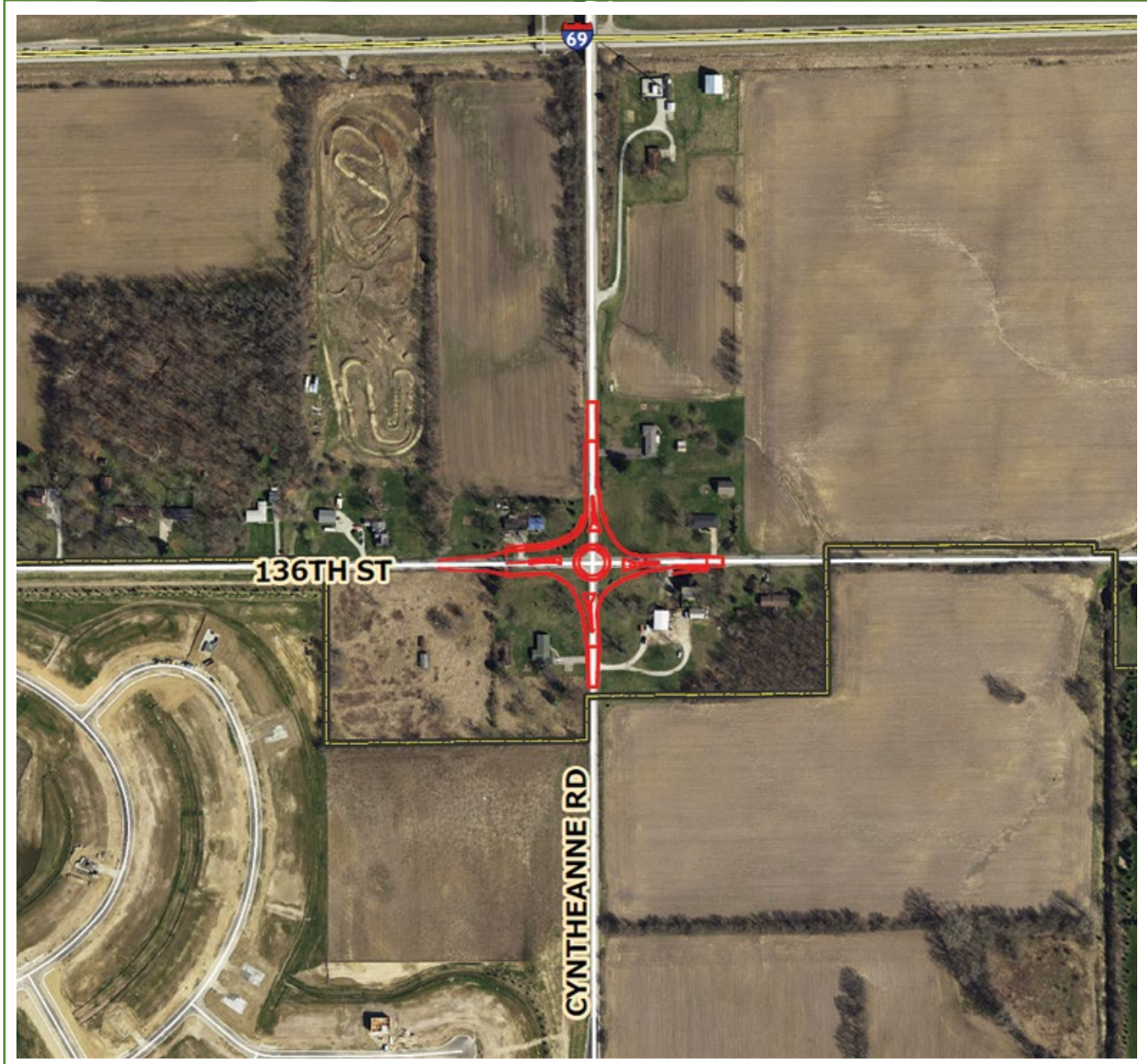
