

96TH STREET RESURFACING & MEDIAN ISLAND RECONSTRUCTION

Drive Fishers is the City of Fishers' initiative to increase travel efficiency, improve connectivity, and maintain the sanitary sewer and water infrastructure via innovative projects and a proactive approach to construction and maintenance.

Since 2012, Drive Fishers has completed traffic calming projects, sanitary and storm sewer projects, 200 resurfaced lane miles, 112 miles of trails and sidewalks, and received more than \$79 million in grants, improving the infrastructure in Fishers while leveraging federal dollars to save money for the Fishers' taxpayers.

Infrastructure improvement projects contribute to long-term vitality of our community and increased economic development opportunities. PROJECT SCOPE

The limits of the work in this project would be 96th Street from the future Nickel Plate Trail to Lantern Road. This project would perform a lane realignment, access management through a grass median with dedicated turn lanes, traffic signal modifications, additional turn lanes for the I-69/96th Street interchange entrance ramps and improve the pavement with a minor structural repair and concrete restoration.

The improvements are in an effort to help improve traffic flow and safety along the 96th Street corridor by optimizing lane utilization and through while positively impacting existing businesses and future economic development projects in Fishers.

96th Street will be open during the duration of this project. Access to businesses will be maintained.
