Patients enrolled in Community Health Network CHOICE program since the start of the program in 2015.



Prompt inpatient detox and initiation onto buprenorphine for pregnant women with opioid use disorders is offered in the OB units at Community East and Community Anderson. Please call those units 24 hours a day for assistance.

**4** OB/GYN doctors and **7** advanced practice providers (nurse practitioners and a physician's assistant) are licensed to prescribe Subutex or Suboxone for treatment of opioid use disorder.



Appropriate patients are admitted to OB for detox and initiation. Some patients may be recommended to go to behavioral health units.



Intensive outpatient services and inpatient rehab facilities are offered through community resources.



Team rounding is utilized for all patients to develop an individualized plan of recovery.



Care Coordination for every patient makes sure she has solutions to social determinants of health.
