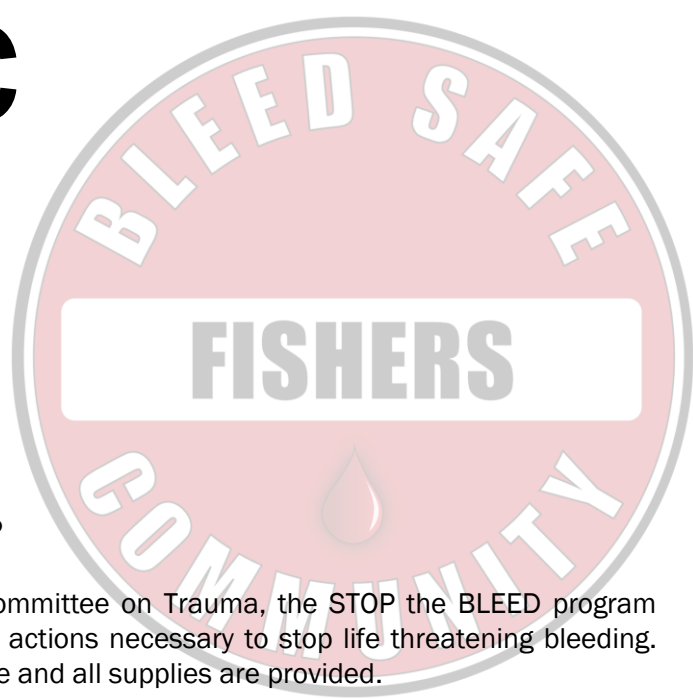


TRAUMATIC INJURY TRAINING



WHAT IS THE STOP THE BLEED PROGRAM?

Administered by the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma, the STOP the BLEED program prepares the public to save lives by training the basic actions necessary to stop life threatening bleeding. Training is typically 1 to 2 hours depending on class size and all supplies are provided.

There are two easy ways to get **FREE STOP the BLEED** training:

1. Contact the Ascension St. Vincent Hospital Outreach Coordinators to set up a class
(recommended for organizations that would like several folks trained at one time)
2. Search for local trainings on the STOP the BLEED website
(recommended for individuals or families)
